TIMES: Monday – Friday, 10am – 4pm; Saturday, 10am – 3pm. Please note, we close for lunch from 12:30-1pm. (Note: we are CLOSED on Sundays) Qualifying families will receive new toys for their children and food gift cards.

To qualify: applicants are families who: • Live in Burnaby • Have children from newborn to 16 years old • Are working families with low income, or families receiving Income Assistance Proof of Income will be required: • Working Families must have a Proof of Income Statement (C-Print) for EACH adult • If you are on Income Assistance (Welfare), you need to request a Release of Information from your Ministry Office. This will replace the C-Print.
